CANADIAN OPINION ON THE CORONA VIRUS PART I

INTRODUCTION

On Friday, in response to the Corona Virus/Covid 19 several exceptional measures were introduced by the government of Canada, amongst them, the suspension of Parliament, the delay of the federal budget, new restrictions on international travel and a major fiscal stimulus package. These measures were a testimony to the increasing seriousness of the virus. But during the week of March 9th Canadians were somewhat divided on the magnitude of the threat posed by the virus. Public attitudes and behaviors are an important aspect in managing the national crisis arising from the virus. To examine opinion the Association for Canadian Studies commissioned a detailed survey of the people's views over the week of March 9th ending the day prior to the PM's announcement. At that time, as revealed in the survey six in ten Canadians were expressed concern about a widespread outbreak and they manifested a variety of other concerns. Still there remains a spectrum or range of concern and anxiety and some differences on the basis age, gender and region. Below is the first of two parts on perceptions about the virus.

METHODOLOGY

• The survey was commissioned by the Association for Canadian Studies and conducted by the firm Leger Marketing with a sample of 1479 Canadians nationally via web panel during the week of March 9, 2020. It has a probabilistic margin of error of 2.5 percent 19 times out of 20.
