INTRODUCTION

- On Friday and Monday in response to the Corona Virus/Covid 19 several exceptional measures were introduced by the government of Canada, amongst them restrictions on international travel and expanded border closings. Other measures that promote various types of distancing as the situation evolves. The spectrum/range of concerns and anxiety on the part of Canadians is likely to rise. There are serious preoccupations about interaction with selected identity groups and fears about people either coming to the country or returning to it from abroad. Some troubling trends may emerge from the distancing as the results of the Leger poll for the Association for Canadian Studies reveal in that which follows.

METHODOLOGY

- The survey was commissioned by the Association for Canadian Studies and conducted by the firm Leger Marketing with a sample of 1479 Canadians nationally via web panel during the week of March 10-13,2020. It has a probabilistic margin of error of 2.5 percent 19 times out of 20.
