OUR JOURNEY DURING THE CRISIS

METHODOLOGY



Started March 11 and ongoing with a total of over 15,500 respondents.



9,000 Canadians and 4,000 Americans, 2,000 immigrants into Canada and now 500 Indigenous Peoples this weekend



Using data from the 2016 Census, results were weighted according to gender, age, mother tongue, region, education level and presence of children in the household in order to ensure a representative sample of the population.



No margin of error can be associated with a non-probability sample (Web panel in this case). However for comparative purposes, a probability sample of 1,504 respondents would have a margin of error of $\pm 2.53\%$, 19 times out of 20, while a probability sample of 1,001 would have a margin of error of $\pm 3.1\%$, 19 times out of 20.

The research results presented here are in full compliance with the CRIC Public Opinion Research Standards and Disclosure Requirements.

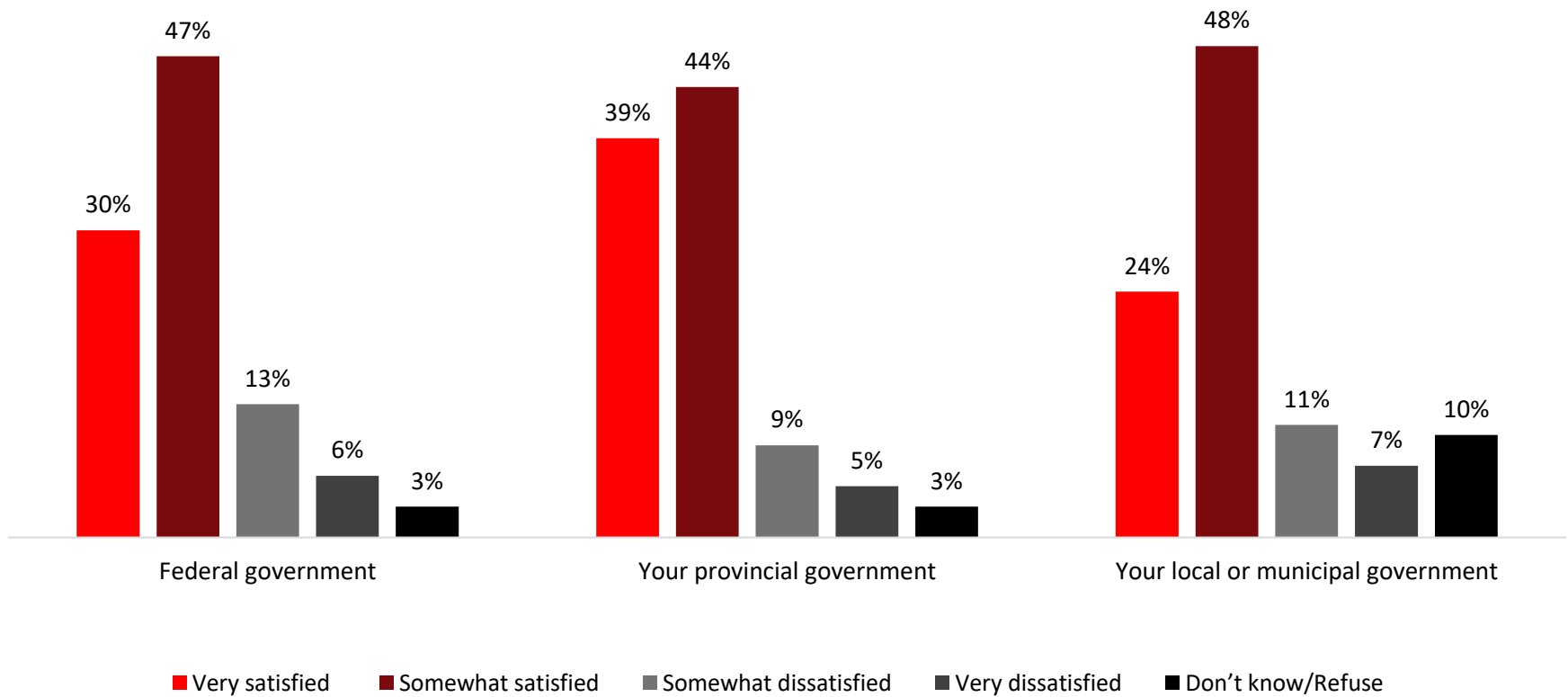

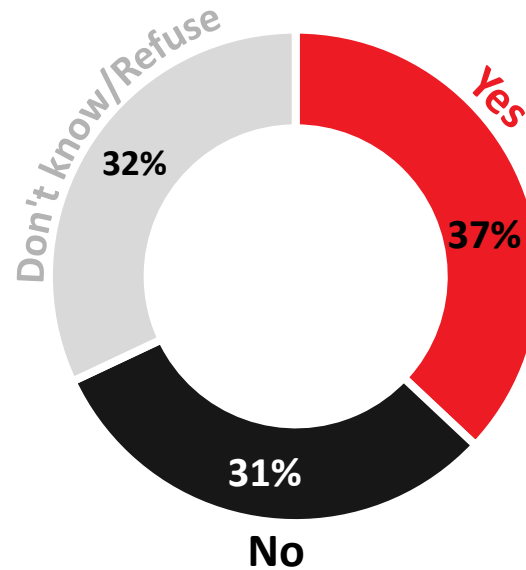

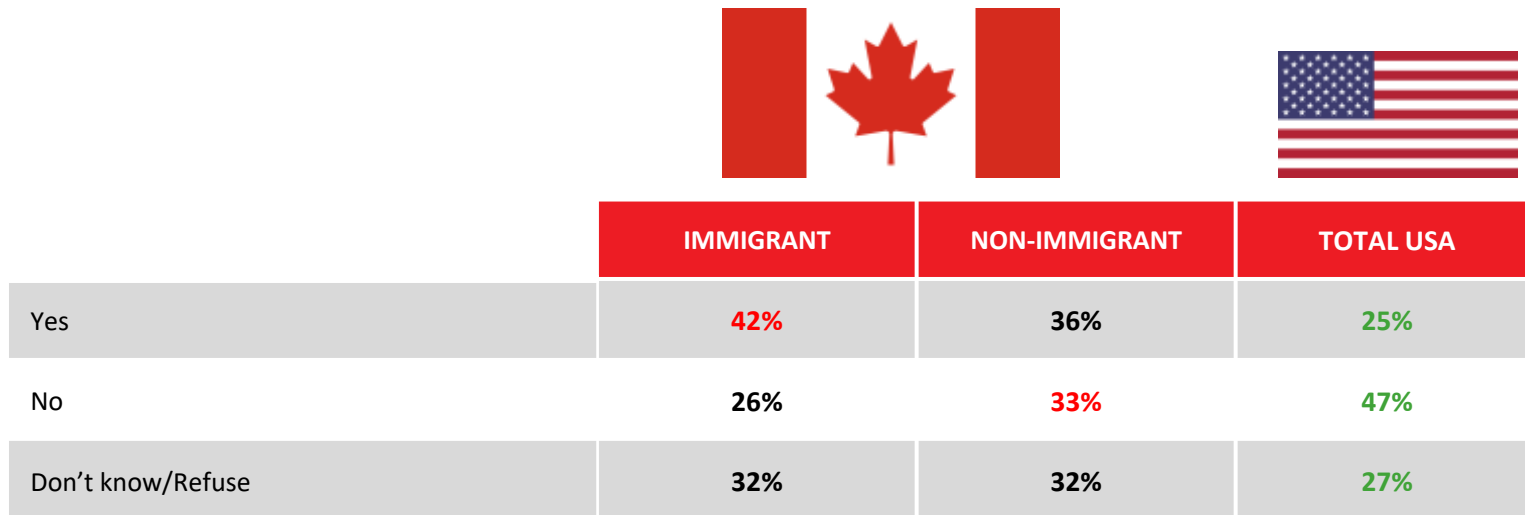

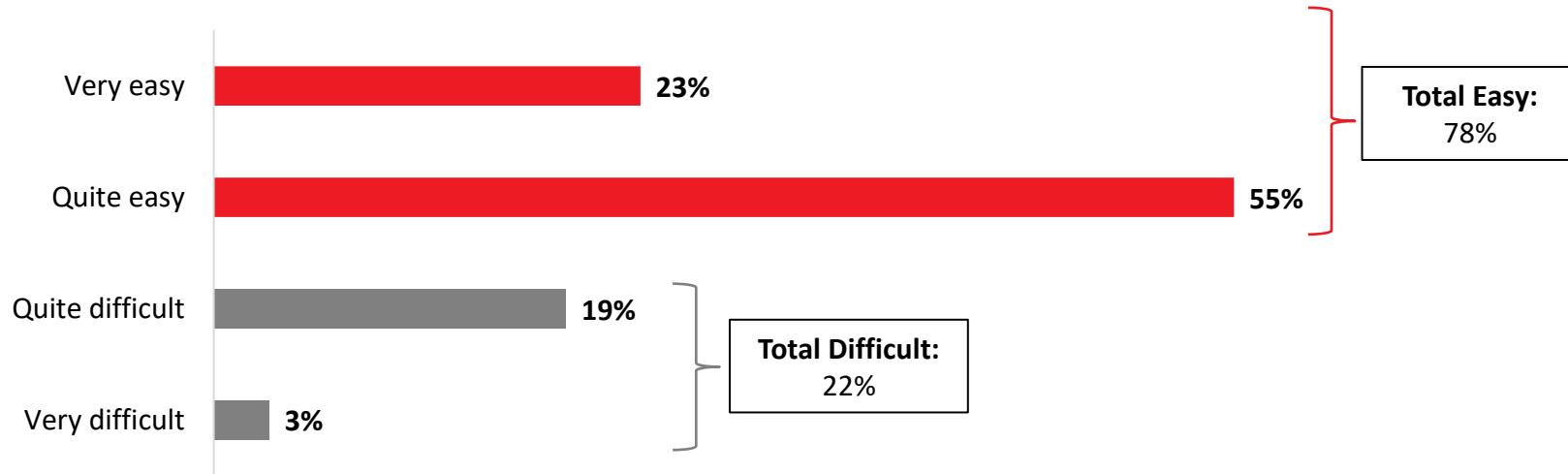

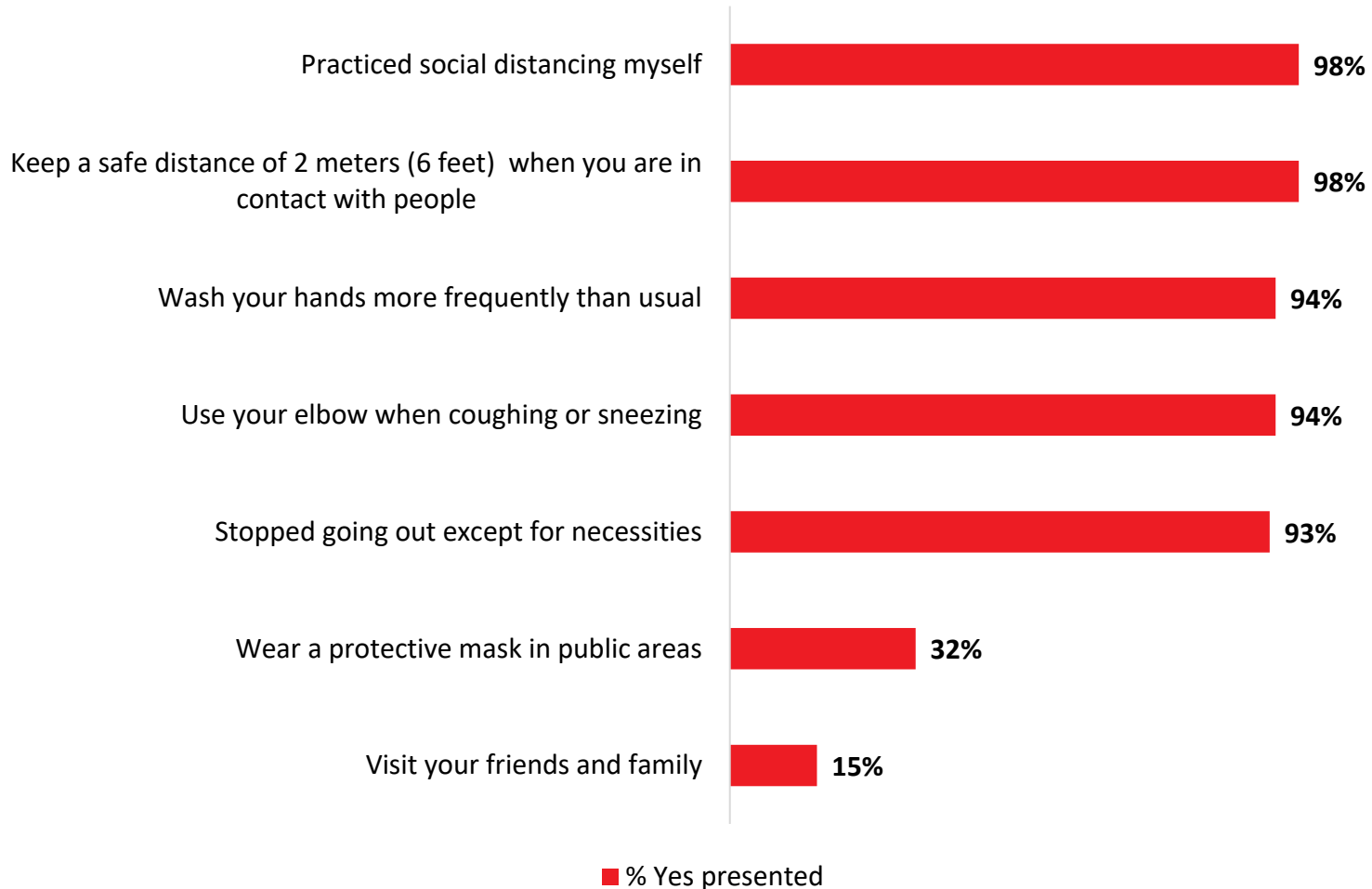

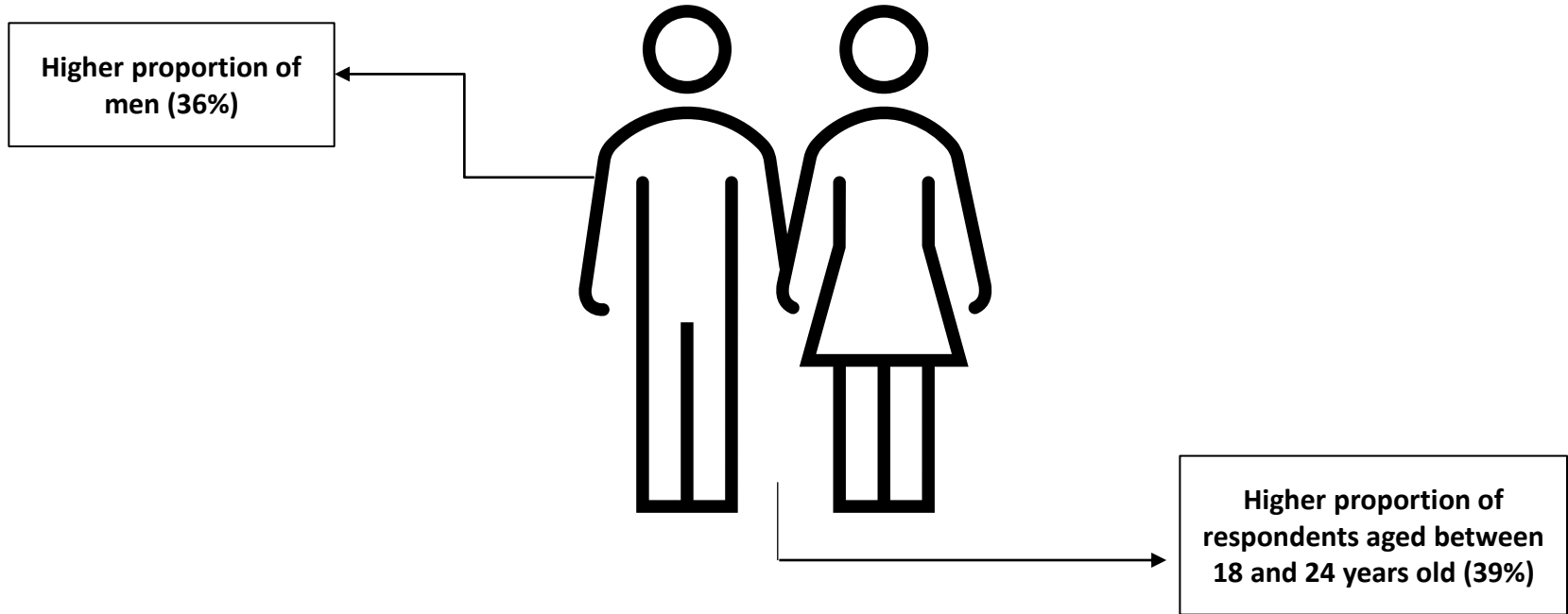

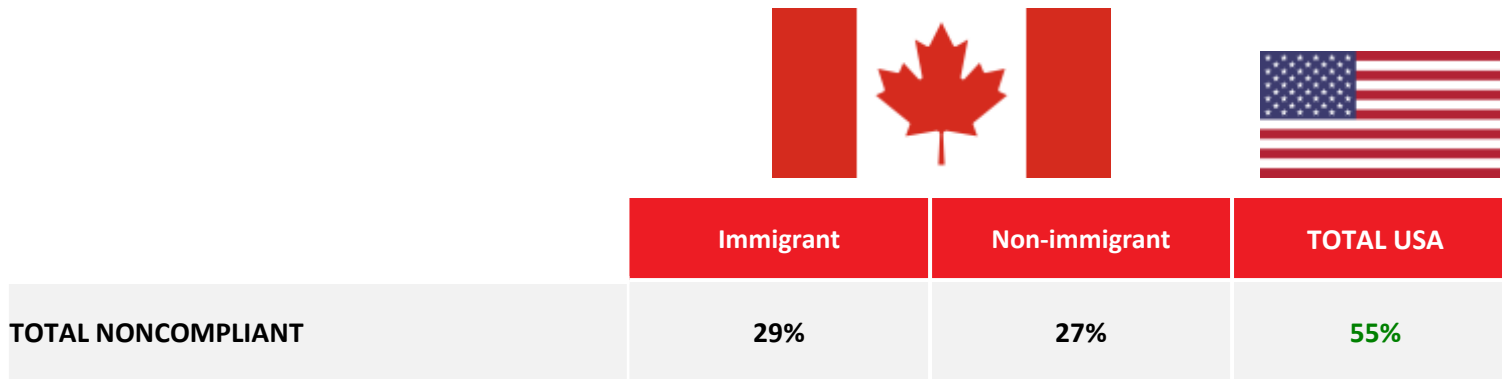

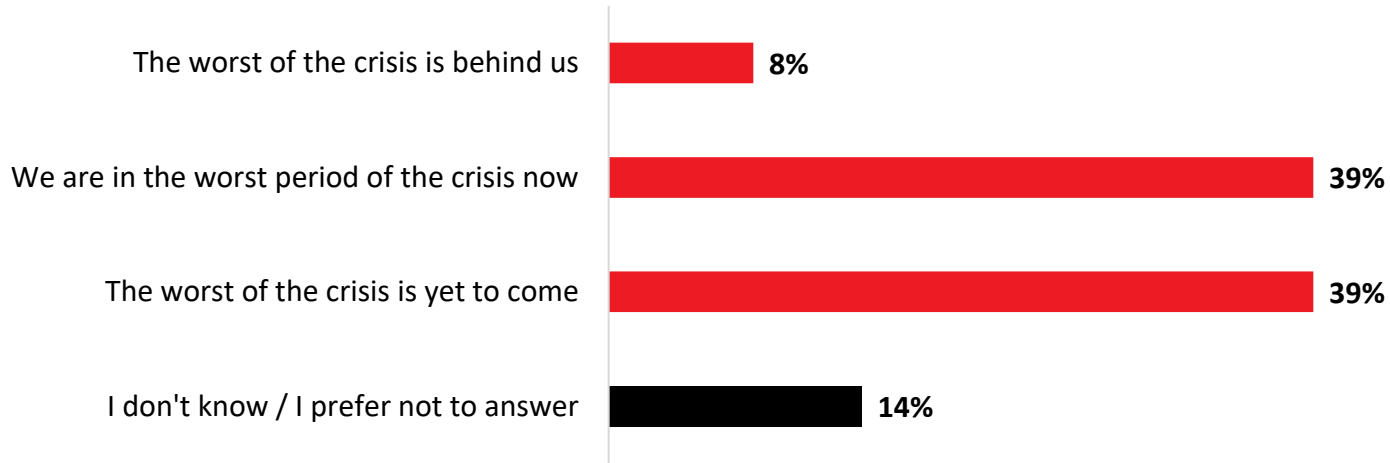
